


STEP 1. Flip Table Top over. Align the legs with the support braces on the table top. Using (4) 1.75" Hex Bolts insert the bolt through a washer, through the material as shown then secure using (1) Barrel Nut. **Tighten all bolts.**







TABLE PARTS

- (1) TABLE TOP
- (4) LEGS
- (1) SEAT ASSEMBLY
- (2) ANGLED BRACES


SUGGESTED TOOLS

- PHILLIPS HEAD SCREWDRIVER

STEP 2. Position the seat assembly as shown. Using (8) 1.75" Hex Bolts thread the bolt through (1) washer, through the material and fasten with (1) Barrel Nut. Do this on the outer leg holes first doing one hole at a time. **Ensure all bolts are fastened tightly.**



STEP 3. Using the (2) angled braces, position them one at a time as shown keeping the pilot hole towards the bottom of the table top. Then using (2) 2" screws and (4) 1-5/8" screws fasten the angled braces to the table top then the seat assembly. Repeat for the other brace. Make sure all bolts and screws are fully tightened, with 1-2 people flip the table upright and enjoy!
