

CARE & CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

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General Cleaning

- Clorox-type wipes or a soft bristle brush with a mild cleanser such as soap and water solution are ideal for this product.
- A soft-bristled toothbrush can be used to clean crevices that are hard to reach.
- Our furniture does not absorb water and requires no painting, staining, or waterproofing.

Deep Cleaning

- For a deeper clean, a pressure washer may be used at its lightest setting to wash away unwanted dirt and residue.
- More than 1,500psi is not recommended for cleaning this product.
- Make sure when pressure washing this product that the tip of the pressure washer is at least 10-12 inches away from the furniture to ensure no damage is done to the product's lumber.

Stain	Chart
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Stain	Recommended Cleaning Process
Grease / Oil & Pencil Marks	Mix dish soap and water into a solution, saturate the stain., then rinse with water.
Ink / Marker	Mix dish soap and water into a solution, saturate the stain, then rinse with water. For stubborn stains, pretreat with WD-40.
mbedded Dirt, Wine, & Bird Droppings	Mix dish soap and water into a solution, saturate the stain, scrub with a soft brush, then rinse with water.
Gum / Wax	Soak WD-40 over the area. Carefully peel up on any potentially hard articles slowly with a plastic knife. Use a soft brush & acetone to remove any fine remains and clean out crevasses, then rinse with water.
Scuffs	Scrub with Magic Eraser.
Rust / Iron	Scrub with Iron Out.

Always be sure to read and follow any cleaning product manufacturers' specific instructions before using. Always test the cleaning solution on an inconspicuous part of the lumber to make sure the surface is not harmed.
